WEEKLY RADAR REPORT 5-2-2021





Technical Market View

It was a very quiet week for the S&P 500 as we closed the month above the 8-EMA and sitting on April VPOC. We remain overstretched and near resistance of a multi-month channel higher while momentum has all but slowed to a crawl. MACD and RSI continue to show a slight negative divergence lately with the indices making new highs but both indicators paring back since 4/16. Both have room to the downside still. The recent lows near 4,115 remain key with a move below, aligning with April VWAP, and below a low-volume gap to 3973.25 from the 4/1 breakout to fill. That would also align with a re-test of the 55-EMA, VWAP from the March lows and the top-end of March value. The upside target remains around 4265 from this recent multi-month consolidation.



Market Sentiment/Breadth

The latest AAII sentiment survey for the week ending 4/28 showed a drop in bullish responses to 42.6% from 52.7% while bearish responses rose to 25.7% from 20.5%. NAAIM Exposure jumped again to extreme levels at 103.72. Lipper Fund Flows showed a \$3.1B outflow from equities, the largest exodus from stocks in almost three months. As of Friday's close, there were 323 new highs vs 48 new lows, more balanced breadth than recently. The percentage of stocks above their 50-day was 59.2% with those above their 200-day at 75%. NYSE Summation rose modestly this week and back above its 8-EMA, although not by much. Cumulative AD hit new highs during the week but pulled back on Friday. NYMO was 12.85, neutral. CBOE Equity P/C 50-MA was 0.47 and remains overly complacent. CNN's Fear and Greed was 66.

Weekly Open Interest Radar

Next-Era (NEE) shares pulling back last week to the low-end of April value and back-testing a multi-week base breakout at \$76.50. A move back above the 8-EMA can setup a run back to \$80+ and then the prior highs around \$85. NEE has a lot of bull flow in open interest including put sales at the May \$75 and September \$72.50 and \$70 strikes as well as over 11,000 June \$80 calls and 7,000 June \$75 calls.

The \$151.5B company trades 28.45X earnings, 8.85X sales, and 4X book with a 2% yield. NEE is coming off a strong quarter and remains well positioned for a number of major thematic trends within the industry including low-cost renewables, low-cost storage and hydrogen, the latter two expanding their TAM significantly. NEE continues to invest in retiring and replacing older, inefficient systems which will drive better rates and more efficient returns long-term. The company also has tailwinds from the infrastructure plan as investments towards renewables and energy infrastructure will benefit them. Analysts have an average target for shares of \$79 with a Street High \$100. Barclays raising estimates in mid-April calling the company the premium U.S. renewable developer. Short interest is 1.35%. Hedge fund ownership rose 0.35% in Q4.

Insider Trade of the Week

JP Morgan (JPM) insiders active buying stock in late April with a director adding \$101,000 in stock at \$153.12, her latest buy after adding \$2M in 2020 around \$136. JPM has been a strong performer in 2021 with shares up 21% and now up around 60% over the last twelve months. Shares are forming a nice bull wedge under \$155 with a breakout above recent highs targeting \$175. The \$470.5B company trades 12.85X earnings, 7.9X book and 0.33X cash with a 2.35% yield. The company is coming off a strong quarter and positive outlook given the rise in loan demand and global recovery. JPM also released about \$5B in reserves held to carry potential loan losses as the economic recovery has support from stimulus and the reopening. Analysts have an average target for shares of \$145. Wells Fargo has a Street High \$195 and out on 4/30 noting that JPM has the best structural positioning in its history at a time when cyclical winds seem at its back. The analyst thinks the bank's model is very scalable, as reflected in the firm's forecast that the pre-tax margin on new revenues over the next 3 years should be 50% higher than it was in 2020. DA Davidson positive on 4/15 given the prospects of improved commercial and credit card loan growth, coupled with the steeper yield curve. Short interest is 0.60%. Hedge fund ownership fell 0.5% in Q4. Sanders Capital adding another 9M shares.

Earnings Preview

Match (MTCH) will report earnings on 5-4 after the close with the Street looking for \$0.40 on \$650.6M in revenues, a 19.5% increase Y/Y. Next quarter is guided to \$0.54 and \$678.76M while the FY is \$2.17 and \$2.84B. Shares have closed higher in three of the last four with an average closing move of 8.5% and a max move of 12.22%. The current implied move is 7%. MTCH has a notable weekly chart setup and bullish options flow as well. A breakout above \$165 has room out to \$210. Last week, the May 7th (W) \$160/\$177.5 call spread was bought 1500X, the May \$160/\$175 call spread was bought 2000X, while the May \$150 calls also with buyers recently. The \$41.65B company trades 57X earnings, 17.5X sales, and 56X cash. MTCH is positioned well for Q2 and beyond in 2021 with the reopening a tailwind for downloads and a resumption in premium buys. The company will also be positioned better for the pent up demand for meet ups with their deal for HyperConnect and likely gives more details on the deal during the call. This quarter is likely to be more muted as COVID continued to drive an uneven pace of lockdown easing. Sensor Tower data, according to BAML, showed app downloads were modestly lower for Tinder in Q1 vs Q420. Analysts have an average target for shares of \$146 with a Street High \$175. BTIG upgraded to Buy on 4/12 seeing upside to the company's 2022-2025 expectations on re-opening tailwinds, new products, Hyperconnect acquisition and emerging brand/live streaming opportunities. The firm also thinks we'll see a resurgence in ARPU for Tinder citing the re-opening, Platinum launch, and the addition of Hyperconnect to drive the upside in the second half of this year. Short interest is 4.65%. Hedge fund ownership rose 4.5% in Q4, Whale Rock a new 2.45M share position.
